


### BECKINGTON PARISH NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN RESIDENTS' SURVEY MARCH 2024



#### Introduction

#### Why do we need a Neighbourhood plan?

Developing a Neighbourhood Plan will help our community play a greater role in shaping the future of our local area. It will allow us to influence decisions about any future development – in particular how local land and buildings should be used and where any new development should be located.

Our 'Neighbourhood' is made up of Beckington village, the hamlet of Rudge and the areas of Standerwick that sit within the Parish. The 'Plan' is being produced by your neighbours; a group of volunteers, with the full support of the Parish Council.

Once completed, a Neighbourhood Plan becomes an important, powerful and legal part of local planning policy.

#### How can I contribute?

Central to the Neighbourhood Planning process is public engagement and consultation - and this questionnaire, which is going out to every household is a vital part of the process. By filling in this survey as fully as possible you will be having your voice heard.




